



1st Hanuman International Grand Slam 2023

November 29 to December 3, 2023

PROBOWL Sports Academy, Phnom Penh, Cambodia

1. Organization and Sanction

- a) 1st Hanuman International Grand Slam is organized by Probowl Sports Academy in cooperation with Cambodian Bowling Federation (CBF) and Sanctioned by the Asian Bowling Federation (ABF). It will be conducted in accordance with the World Bowling Playing Rules as of September 2019.
- b) This tournament will be held from November 29 to December 3, 2023 at Probowl Sports Academy, Phnom Penh, Cambodia.

2. Eligibility

- a) This tournament is open only to **Bowlers with 200 and below average** current paid up members of CBF & ABF affiliates. All overseas participants must obtain clearance from their respective National Tenpin Bowling Congress / Federation.

3. Averages

- a) Only official average of CBF will be used.
- b) Overseas bowlers must produce written confirmation of their latest current year averages from their respective National Congress / Federation in order to be eligible to participate.

4. Registration

a) Tournament Fees:

Registration fee: **50USD (1 time payment)**
 Entry fee: **400USD (inclusive of Qualifying and Master)**





- b) No refund shall be made after an entry has been registered and accepted (Unless in the case of a positive Covid-19 test).
- c) A participant who fails to show up for the scheduled squad shall be disqualified from participation and the entry fee is forfeited.
- d) Changes to squad schedules will be permitted provided lanes have not been drawn from any squads and vacancies for the preferred squad. (applicable to all participants).
- e) **For Overseas Participants**, please submit your hotel and hotel rooming list, flight schedule and Squad reservation (subject to availability) on or before **31st October 2023**.
- f) Slots available per squad as follows:
 - Squad A – 36 slots**
 - Squad B – 36 slots**
 - Squad C – 36 slots**
 - Squad D – 36 slots**

There will be a total of **144 slots** in this tournament. Slots are on a first come, first served basis. In the event of all slots are taken, a waiting list will be established.

5. Format of play

a) Qualifying Round – 3 days (5 games per day)

All bowlers will bowl 15 games in the qualifying round divided in to 3 blocks of 5 games in three (3) days, on three different time slots and on **Three Designated Lane Patterns**.

Day One Oil Pattern : Short

Day Two Oil Pattern : Long

Day Three Oil Pattern : Medium

Desperado Squad: One game will be bowled in this event, after last squad of Block B Bowlers on Third Day 1/12/ 2023. The Top 4 Bowlers from 1 game roll-off will proceed to join top 68 bowlers from 3 days qualifying rounds in the Semifinal 5 games roll-off.

Desperado Squad Entry Fees: US\$ 50





b) Semifinals – 72 Bowlers (Top 68 bowlers from Qualifying Round and 4 Bowlers Desperado Squad.)

72 bowler will contest the in semifinals rounds. The semifinals will be bowled in 2 squads based on the position standing from the qualifying round.

- **Squad A** 36 Bowlers (Bowlers ranked 37th - 68th Plus 4 Bowlers (Desperado Squad).
- **Squad B** 36 Bowlers (Bowlers ranked 1st – 36th).

5 games shall be bowled. Scores to start from scratch.

- **Lane Oil Pattern for Semi-finals Round** : The Top Highest Rank Position Bowler From 3 days qualifying rounds /15 games with Handicap will choose from the Qualifying rounds Lane Oil Pattern of Short / Medium / Long which Oiling pattern to be used for semi-finals round.

The top 24 Bowlers from semifinals round 5 games roll-off will then advance to the Final Round Head to Head Match Play Finals.

c) Final Rounds - Head to Head Match Play Finals

1. Top 24 bowlers from Semifinal (5 games) will proceed to Match Play Final with knock out Stages as per schedule below.
2. **Lane Oil Pattern for Head to Head Match Play Finals Round:** The Top Highest Rank Position Bowler From Semi- Finals rounds / 5 games with Handicap will get to choose which Oiling pattern to be used for all match play finals round. i.e. Short / Medium / Long
3. **Pre- arranged Schedule**
Top 2 bowlers after the Semifinals (5 games) Roll Off will be seeded as follows:
Ranked # 2 – will join on stage 2
Ranked # 1 – will join on stage 4





4. Each Match Play in any Stage will be over 2 games only.

(When 2 games are won, that said match is over).

In case of a Tie in any game or match, the Tiebreaker, shall be a One Ball Roll Off and continued until the tie is broken and a winner is declared accordingly.

The highest Ranked Bowler (5 games in semi-final roll-off) will get the right to decide who will bowl 1st during any Tie Breaker, if any.

5. The Losers in Stage 4 Head to Head Roll-off will get a chance to bowl another Match Play to determine final position for 3rd and 4th place. Same format will still apply.

6. The Winner of Stage 5 will be declared **1st Hanuman International Grand Slam Champion** and the Losing opponent will be declared 2nd Place.

6. Tie Breaking Procedure

- When a tie on the 68th position after the 3 days of Qualifying, it shall be broken by a one ball roll off. This process will continue until the tie is broken.
- When a tie is registered on the 24th position or any position in the Top 24 after the Semifinals, a one ball Roll off shall be held. This process will continue until the tie is broken.

7. Bowling Balls

- It is the bowler's responsibility to ensure that all bowling balls used during the tournament are conforming to International Bowling Federation (IBF) Rules and Regulations. The Tournament committee reserves the right to examine the balls used by the participants. Use of illegal ball is grounds for disqualification and forfeiture of all games, prizes and standing aside from any other penalties that may be imposed.





- b) Altering the surface of bowling balls is allowed in a designated area during the official practice session, during the practice session immediately preceding competition round and in between games. A player may not alter the surface of the bowling ball during a game.

8. Slow bowling

- a) Slow bowling is strictly not allowed and bowlers must bowl when it is their turn to do so.
- b) Players shall be ready to bowl when it is their turn and shall not delay the start of their approach or delivery if the lanes immediately adjacent to them on both the right and left are clear.

9. Bowler's Attire

Bowlers are required to be properly and appropriately dressed for bowling. If, in the opinion of the Tournament Committee, a bowler is not appropriately dressed, he / she may not be permitted to bowl. Male Bowlers must pants or slacks and are not allowed to wear sleeveless shirts and / or jeans, shorts and bermudas. Female bowlers may wear skirts, shorts, pants, slacks or dress shorts and are not allowed to wear sleeveless shirts and / or jeans.

10. Verification of Scores

It is the bowler's responsibility to ensure that the score for each game bowled is recorded on the scoreboard.

11. Interrupted Game(s)

- a) The Tournament Director may authorize the completion of a game and series on another pair of lanes when equipment failure on the lanes would delay the normal process of the series. An interrupted game and series that cannot be completed must resume from the point of interruption.
- b) In the event the score of any game is lost and / or erased and cannot be recovered due to power or equipment failure, the bowler concerned will required to re-bowl a new game when the power supply resumes or equipment is repaired. However, all scores of completed games that have been recorded in the official score sheet shall remain unchanged.
- c) Lane Breakdown if a pair of lanes becomes unusable or unplayable before or during the squad games as determined by the Tournament Director, any available pair of





d) lanes provided by the bowling center shall be assigned to affected participant(s) or shall wait for the next available squad. In case of machine breakdown during the Finals, vacant lanes shall be assigned to affected finalist. Any interrupted game(s) or series must resume from the point (frame) of interruption. No practice throw(s) shall be allowed. In the event that a next available squad is offered in place, participants will be given the same amount of practice time as recorded to the rest of the squad.

12. Protest

Protest involving eligibility or general playing rules must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Committee not later than 24 hours after the game in which the infraction occurred or before prize presentation, whichever is sooner. If no written protest is filed prior to the expiration period as stated above, the game or games shall stand as bowled. Each protest under this rule shall not be construed to cover a similar or previous violation.

13. Matters Not Provided

The Tournament Committee whose decision shall be governed by IBF General Rules and Regulations, shall decided on any matter arising, which is not covered in these Rules and Regulations. Such decision shall be final, subject only to an appeal to be made in writing to within 24 hours of the decision of the Tournament Committee.

d) Top 24 Final Ranking Position

To determine the final ranking position for prizes the total pinfalls from 5 games bowled during the semifinals plus whatever games bowled from Stage 1 to Stage 3 will determine the position of bowlers from 5th – 24th placing.

For final position for top 4 placing will be as follows.

Stage 4: 1st Match Play: Winners of this 1st Match Play will proceed to Stage 5 Grand Final

Stage 4: 2nd Match play – Losers of Stage 4 Match play will roll off another match to determine the 3th and 4th Placing of this Grand Slam

Stage 5: Winner will be the Champion and Losing Opponent 2nd Position
